Minutes of Committee Meeting, April 14, 2004

The meeting commenced at 7:07 p.m.

- 1. Larry Crilly's treasure report shows a checking account balance of \$4,413.54 plus miscellaneous funds giving the Troop a total balance of \$4,843.72. After deducting summer camp funds on account and boy accounts, the net Troop funds available is \$2,831.11.
